### YOUNG BIRD National Raumati Saturday 28 May 2016

**BASKETING NIGHT:** Thursday 26 May 2016 (Finger food available).

**BASKETING VENUE** At our Headquarters Te Papapa Bowling Clubrooms: 138a Captain Springs Road, Te Papapa Open 6.30pm.

BASKETING will start from: 6.30pm with deadline 8.00pm.

**LOFT Auction:** will be held at 8.30 pm following basketing

**RACE SHEETS and POOLS:** The race sheets will be delivered to each Club by Friday 20th May 2016. Please fill in the Clock Type and Number, fill in the colour and sex of the Pigeons you are going to send, plus pools and 3 clock 2 Teams if you wish. Pools are \$ 20 \$10, \$5, \$2, \$1. \$10 per 3 CLOCK 2.

**TEAM:** For the new members and others that may have forgotten. A competitor may enter the 3 clock 2 team's race. There is no limit on entries (An Out of Area may want a team entered.) The competitor enters on the race sheet in the 3x2 Team column, to be completed before basketing pigeons. (Example: Team 1: mark three pigeons with 1. Team 2: mark three different pigeons with 2. and so on. When the competitor has more than one team the competitor cannot nominate any of the same Pigeons for another team or teams. (All must be separate pigeons for each team). The velocities are worked out by the WINGS P R S by Polytimer Limited. The Highest velocity wins.

**ELECTRONIC CLOCKS:** Please ensure your clock has had previous races and data deleted "Before" presenting it for basketing. As per Federation rule 6.5 c) page 32 all basketing lists must be signed by the race secretary or a designated person and the competitor. The designated person will be the person who is using the electronic clocking scanner/s.

**Ownership of Pigeons:** Any life ring not officially registered, under the competitors name or Out of Area and handler names they will be disqualified from all races they enter. It is the responsibility of the competitor to check that their electronic clocking list has the life ring details and Colour of pigeons correct, as that list will be checked for ownership of pigeons. For manual clocks the details on the race sheet will be checked. **NO CLOCK TO BE REMOVED UNTIL THE RACE RESULT PERSON** (Roger Smith) has recorded all details required.

**WORKING BEE:** Tuesday 24th May 2016 At our Headquarters Te Papapa Bowling Clubrooms. Starting at 6.30pm. The Federation requires at least one member from each Club for the preparation of the race crates to be set up ready for basketing. (All members are welcome many hands make light work.)
